

DECORAH CHAMBER OF COMMERCE  
AGREEMENT REACH ON CITY FLAG DISPLAY  
MAY 12, 1976

1. The flags will not be flown at night or during inclement weather.
2. When a holiday occurs on Sunday and is actually celebrated on Monday, the flags will be flown on Monday only.
3. The holidays on which flags will be flown are as follows:  
Washington's Birthday - 3rd Monday in February  
Viet Nam Veterans Day - March 29  
V.E. Day (Victory in Europe) - May 8  
Armed Forces Day - 3rd Saturday in May  
Norwegian Day - May 17  
Memorial Day - last Monday in May  
Flag Day - June 14  
Independence Day - July 4  
Nordic Fest - last full weekend in July (Fri, Sat, Sun)  
V.J. Day (Victory in Japan) - September 2  
Labor Day - 1st Monday in September  
Veteran's Day - November 11  
Election Day - First Tuesday after the first Monday in Nov.  
Presidential Inauguration - every fourth year
4. On non-scheduled occasions when an organization feels that the flags should be flown, the Street Commissioner must be notified at least 48 hours in advance. The decision as to whether or not they shall be flown for such occasion will be made by the Street Commission and the Executive Director of the Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber of Commerce will serve as a clearing house for such requests.
5. Any person who in any manner desecrates the flag or any person who steals the flag will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
