Armed Forces Day - 3rd Saturday in May

Norwegian Day - May 17

Memorial Day - last Monday in May

Nordic Fest - last full weekend in July (Fri, Sat, Sun)

- 4. On non-scheduled occasions when an organization feels that the flags should be flown, the Street Commissioner must be notified at least 48 hours in advance. The decision as to whether or not they shall be flown for such occasion will be made by the Street Commission and the Executive Director of the Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber of Commerce will serve as a clearing house for such requests.
- 5. Any person who in any manner desecrates the flag or any person who steals the flag will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
