ATTENTION TROUT RUN TRAIL USERS! TRAIL CLOSURE AT BOWSTRING BRIDGE PARK BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 15, 2016 AND MAY 15, 2017

The construction of the Bowstring Bridge/Trout Run Park roadway, parking lots and canoe access will require the intermittent detour of 300 feet of the trail corridor in the vicinity of the park between September 15, 2016 and May 15, 2017.

The trail will remain open for the Loop de Loop 5K and Half-Marathon on September 24th. Trail access will be maintained to the extent it is safe for the public via a temporary rock connection across the roadway grading or temporary mowed trail around the construction site.
